

## Greene County Ladies/Shepherds Lead Line Class

Everyone, here is your chance! It is open to all Greene County, 4H and FFA. We hope you will join in the fun. It will be held Monday, August 8, 2022 in the 4H Barn. The purpose of this show is to promote the Sheep Industry, woolen products and Good American Lamb. An entry blank is enclosed. Wool fabric may be difficult to obtain this year. If you need assistance, please contact Lead Line Coordinators.

### RULES

1. Entries are due before the show.
2. Animals must be halter shown.
3. The animal must be broken to lead on a halter and groomed for show. Animals may be exhibited in long or short fleece.
4. Garments must be made of fabric consisting of 70% Wool. The garment does not have to be made by the exhibitor. The garments may also be purchased.
5. Contestants will be judged on the participant's poise and general appearance, presentation, behavior, and grooming of their sheep.
6. There will be five divisions:
  - Teeny Tiny Tots 3 to 4 Years (as of January 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - Tiny Tots 5 to 7 Years (as of January 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - Juniors 8 to 11 Years (as of January 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - Intermediates 12 to 14 Years (as of January 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - Seniors 15 to 18 Years (as of January 1<sup>st</sup>)
7. Decorations on sheep are permitted and Highly encouraged.
8. Awards will be given for each of the five divisions.
