

Greene County Ladies/Shepherds Lead Line Class

Come one and all and join the fun! Monday Night @ 7:00pm of the Greene County Fair!!! Monday, August 7, 2023 in the 4-H Barn. The purpose of this show is to promote the Sheep Industry and wool products. An entry blank is enclosed. Wool fabric may be difficult to obtain this year. If you need assistance, please contact Lead Line Coordinators.

RULES

1. Entries are due before the show.
2. Animals must be halter shown.
3. The animal must be broken to lead on a halter and groomed for show. Animals may be exhibited in long or short fleece.
4. Garments must be made of fabric consisting of 70% Wool. The garment does not have to be made by the exhibitor. The garments may also be purchased.
5. Contestants will be judged on the commercial participant's poise and general appearance, presentation, behavior, and grooming of their sheep.
6. Division of the contestants will be as follows, age as of **January 1, 2023**:
 - a. Teeny Tiny Tots - 3 to 5 years of age
 - b. Tiny Tots - 6 to 8 years of age
 - c. Juniors - 9 to 11 years of age
 - d. Intermediates - 12 to 14 years of age
 - e. Seniors - 15 to 18 years of age
 - f. Adults – 19 years of age and older
7. Decorations on sheep are permitted and Highly encouraged!!!!!! Should correspond with the contestants outfit.
8. Awards will be given for each of the divisions.
9. Sashing and Crowning the Supreme Contestant.

*****ANIMAL BEING USED ONLY FOR LEAD LINE CONTEST*****

1. Animal arrives/leaves the fairgrounds the day of the contest. (Monday)
2. Animal has to have Vet Papers.
3. Animal is to be checked in by designated person (Jim Cowell or Lew Crouse).
