# General Rules for all Home & Garden Departments

**Home & Garden Check-In** ..... Sunday, August 4, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

**Home & Garden Judging** ..... Monday, August 5, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. (closed to public)

**Home & Garden Pick-Up** ..... Sunday, August 11, 2019 from noon to 2:00 p.m.

## Rules and Regulations:

1. There is a \$0.25 per item entry fee in all these departments. Entry fees must accompany entry blanks.
2. All exhibits should be pre-registered by June 30. Exhibitors are encouraged to list every entry that they may have available to bring. No refunds on entry's.
3. Entries for exhibitors 19 and under should be entered in Department 11. Entries received in any other home and garden department will compete with adult entries.
4. Actual items to be exhibited will be accepted ONLY between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 4, 2019.
5. Fair management reserves the right to refuse to accept any entry deemed by fair management to be in poor taste.
6. Fair management has the right to open any and all canned good items!
7. Only two\* entries per category per exhibitor will be accepted. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to decide in which category an item will be entered. *\*Note: Canned Products, Butters, Spreads, Jams, Jellies, Marmalades & Preserves will only accept one entry per category.*
8. Judging for the Home & Garden classes will take place on Monday, August 5. No exhibitors or spectators will be permitted in the hall during the judging.
9. Any entry not deemed worthy will not be placed. Judges' decisions are final.
10. "Best of Show" rosettes will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
11. Exhibits will be guarded and every effort will be made to protect them from damage. However, neither the Fair Board nor the management is responsible for accidents, loss or damage.
12. Fair management may at any time order the removal of any exhibit or part of any exhibit that has become unfit for show.
13. Exhibits will be removed from the hall only on Sunday, August 11, 2019 between noon and 2:00 p.m. No exceptions will be made. Perishable items will be destroyed if not picked up at this time – others will be kept for one week. If you have any questions, contact Jean Scott at 724-627-9756.

- Recipe(s) must be submitted with the entry, printed on one side of 8-1/2"x11" paper. Recipe must list all ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions. **The PA Preferred™ ingredients must be listed clearly in the ingredient list, specifying the ingredients and the company that made/grew them** *(ex. PA Preferred Eggs - Weis brand; PA Preferred Milk - Galliker's brand)*. Entrant's name, age, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. (All recipes and cookies-brownies-bars will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
- A PA Preferred™ logo is not required because not all PA Preferred™ products carry the label. The name of the ingredient and the source is sufficient. For a list of acceptable products, visit papreferred.com. Additionally, PA Preferred™ staff will assist in locating PA Preferred™ ingredients, as needed.
- Refrigeration is not available at the fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.

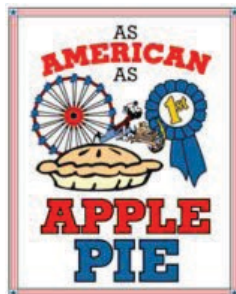

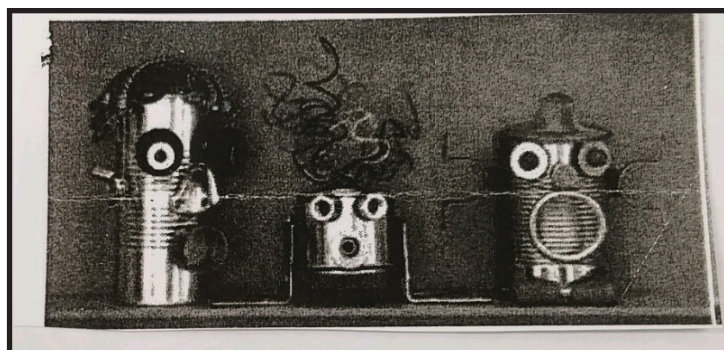

The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture will once again conduct a statewide poster contest at the agriculture fairs. Participating fairs will hold their own contest and submit one poster from each age group to the state level for additional judging and cash prizes.

#### RULES

1. Only one poster may be submitted per exhibitor, per age group. There will be three state competitions: ages 8-11, 12-14, and 15-18. Exhibitors must be in one of these age groups as of June 1 of the current fair season to qualify.
  2. The poster size must be either 14 x 22 inches or 14 1/2 x 22 inches. Other sizes will not be accepted for judging at the state level.
  3. This year's theme is "Inspiring PA's Agriculture Story". Contestants are asked to submit artwork that celebrates the ways in which the commonwealth's diverse agriculture industry has shaped our communities and contributed to Pennsylvania's standing as a worldwide leader in agricultural, food and lumber production. Exhibitors using other themes will be disqualified at the state level.
  4. Posters must be flat. Posters rolled or folded will be ineligible for judging.
  5. Posters will be evaluated on use of the theme, visual appearance and creativity in relation to the exhibitor's age.
- All entrees must be brought into the Home & Garden Department on Sunday, August 4, 2019 between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
  - The first place winners' posters will be sent to the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture by the Greene County Fair for the state competition.
  - State Competition Premiums: First - \$100.00; Second - \$75.00; Third - \$50.00.
  - State Competition winners will be notified in advance and invited to attend an awards presentation at the Pennsylvania Farm Show in January 2020. They will also be required to provide their social security numbers for award disbursements.
