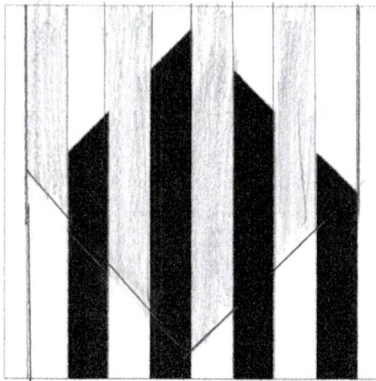


Modern Quilt Block Series

Woven



Cut list: ✕

From fabric A, cut:

- 2 rectangles, 1" x 9 1/2"
- 2 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 5"
- 2 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 4"
- 2 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 3"
- 2 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2"

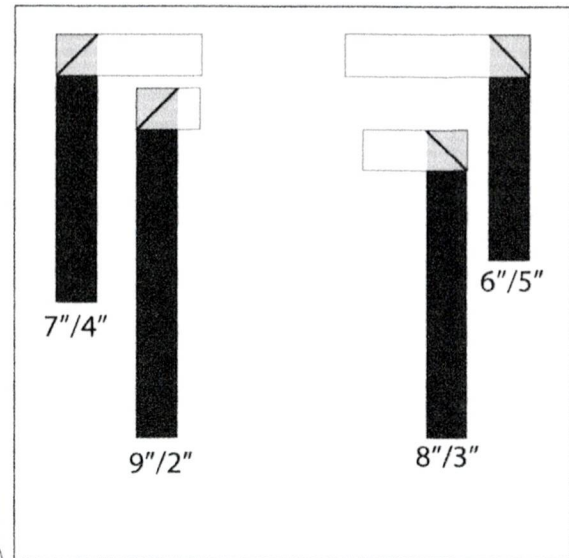
From fabric B, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 9"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 8"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 7"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 6"

From fabric D, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 9"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 8"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 7"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 6"

CUT THESE
1 1/2" x 9 1/2" -
BETTER FOR
SQUARING
UP



Block Construction:

- 1 - Overlap the A and D 1 1/2" rectangles as shown, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner, and sew ON the marked line. Repeat with the remaining A and B 1 1/2" rectangles.
- 2 - Trim the seam allowances to 1/4", and press toward the dark fabric.
- 3 - Arrange the 10 rectangles into the block formation, and sew together. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

* CUT STRIPS LONGER TO
ALLOW "SQUARING UP" TO 9"

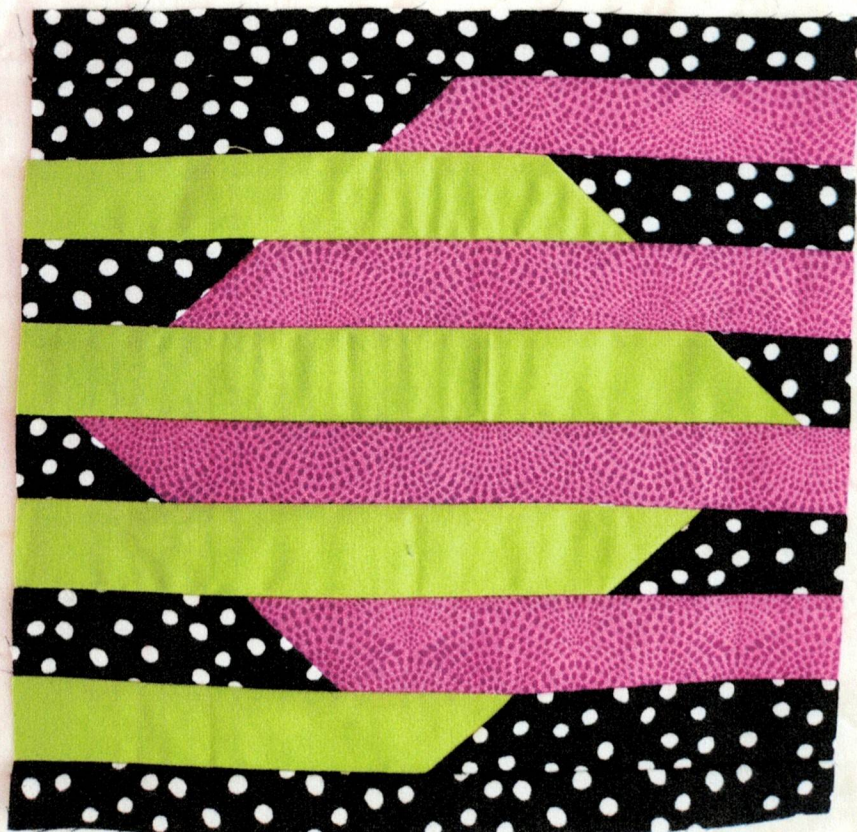
• MY BLOCKS ENDED UP 9x9
WITH ACURATE 1/4" SEAM = 9" WIDE

FABRICS

Fabric A = Background → BLACK ON WHITE OR WHITE ON BLACK
 Fabric B = light
 Fabric C = medium → BRIGHT COLORS - CONTRASTING
 Fabric D = dark

Trim completed block to 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"
