

The quilt pattern is designed for an advanced beginner, there are no Y-seams, paper piecing, or appliqué in the quilt and the quilt finishes at a generous lap size of 60 ½" x 72 ½".

PATTERN NOTES:

- Width of fabrics (WOF) for this pattern is assumed to be 40".
- A scant ¼" (a thread width smaller than ¼") seam is to be used throughout the construction of the quilt unless otherwise instructed.

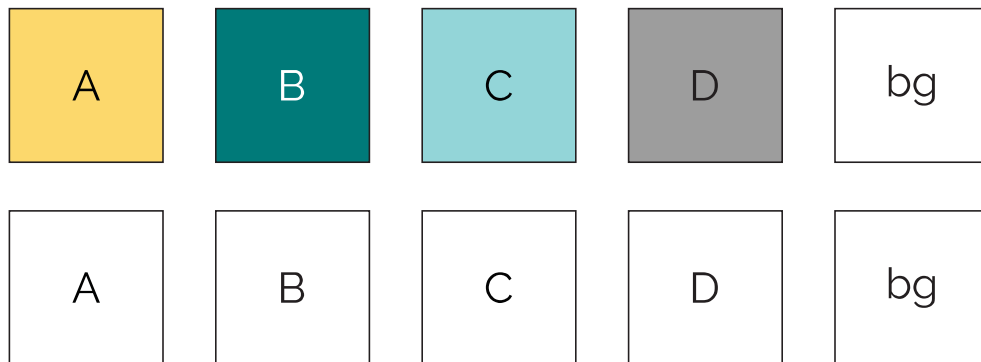
Fabric Requirements

Finished Size	60 ½" x 72 ½"
Fabric A	¾ yard
Fabric B	¾ yard
Fabric C	¾ yard
Fabric D	¾ yard
Background fabric	4 ¼ yards
Binding Fabric	⅝ yd
Backing Fabric	3 ⅞ yds
Batting	69" x 81"

Fabric Selection Tips

- It is suggested that a solid or a tone-on-tone print that reads as a solid be used for the background fabric.
- Due to the finished fabric piece sizes and piecing methods for the quilt top, it is recommended that fabric prints used have a non-directional design.
- Each of the fabrics may be made using scraps of similar colors instead of a single fabric if desired. Generally, the pieces within the quilt will be 6" x 6" or smaller.
- Within the quilt, all of the A, B, C, and D fabrics are adjacent the background fabric, but none of the A, B, C, or D fabrics are next to each other.
- In these instructions, the background is shown as white, but the quilt design looks very good with other colors and tones of background (light, medium, and dark) as long as the A-D fabrics have good contrast with the background color.

Within these quilt instructions, the following colors will be used to represent the fabrics:
