Fire, Rescue and ALS Emergency Medical Services



Tiki Island Fire and Rescue is a combination fire department that is made up of volunteers who are supplemented by 1 paid personnel 24/7. As a first responder organization, Tiki Island Fire and Rescue provides services to the Village of Tiki Island, IH-45 and surrounding communities through a mutual aid agreement. Tiki Island Volunteer Fire Department has 3 apparatus that allow services to be provided in both fire and medical operations.

Do you want to help?

You can volunteer in a number of ways!

- As a firefighter – No experience is required. However, it will require attending regular training meetings at the fire department and outside Fire and EMS schools (Depending on the level of training, 6 weeks may be required.)
- As a pump truck operator – will require some training, but you do not have to complete full firefighter training.
- As support staff – with some training, you can assist with the hoses and other duties.
- TIVFD will pay the cost associated with your training.
- As a citizen – you can help with fundraising, other community events and support functions.

Meetings and Training sessions are held at the Public Safety Building @ 747 Tiki Drive. They are usually held on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of each month at 5:30pm. (Call ahead to confirm date and time). Feel free to attend to meet departmental personnel and learn how you can become a member or otherwise help us. In addition, the Tiki VFD Fire Board meetings are at 5:30pm the 2nd Tuesday of each month and are open to the public.
