RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Cooking teams will consist of a chief cook and can have up to four (4) assistants
2. Entry registration at Village of Tiki Island Offices, 802 Tiki Dr. Tiki Island, TX. **Entry deadline is, Thursday, March 5th, 2020 @ 5:00 p.m.** Check-in times 12:00p.m. till 3:00 p.m. Friday April 3rd, 2020. NO SMOKING PITS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE COOK-OFF JUDGING AREA. ***PLEASE DONATE A CASE OF SOFT DRINKS AND A CASE OF WATER WHEN YOU TURN IN YOUR ENTRY REGISTRATION.**
3. The cook-off committee will provide one (1) 30'x30' standard space for the cook-off team on a first come first serve basis. Props, trailers, motorhomes, tents, coverings, or any other part of the cook-off team's equipment must not exceed the boundaries of spaces assigned.
4. Only 1 vehicle per space will be allowed in the cook-ff area. A vehicle making a delivery to a cooking area may enter the area. After making the necessary delivery, the vehicle must leave the cooking area. Vehicles must not block the aisle used for vehicular traffic.

5. Fire must be wood or a wood substance (charcoal). NO GAS OR ELECTRIC PITS. NO HOLES OR DUG IN PITS
6. Meats to be cooked for the judging must be brisket, chicken, or ribs. More than one piece of meat may be entered in the cook-off. Meat must be uncooked and unseasoned. No precooked meat will be allowed.
 - 6a. Brisket must be a minimum of 10 lbs. prior to trimming and cooking
 - 6b. Ribs must be pork spare ribs or St. Louis only, no baby back or country style
 - 6c. Chicken can be any part of the bird: legs, wings, thighs, breasts, or half a bird

MEAT TO BE ENTERED IN THE COOK-OFF WILL BE INSPECTED ON FRIDAY, April 3rd, 2020 FROM 3:00 P.M. TO 4:00 P.M. BY THE BAR-B-QUE COMMITTEE OR AN OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE.

7. When the Bar-B-Que committee calls for a meat to be delivered to the judging stand, no sauces, garnishes, foil, etc. will be allowed in the box, meat only. All others will be disqualified. 6 pieces of Meat to be delivered in the container issued during the Chief Cooks meeting. The container must not be damaged or altered in any way. In case of a tie breaker, you may be required to turn in a second box meeting the same requirements of the first box. No meat samples will be accepted after the time limit called. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
8. Wild Card category can be any category that the team chooses. (desserts, appetizers, exotic meat, seafood, cocktails, etc.) Just as the other entries there needs to be 6 pieces submitted for judging. If a wild card entry requires a special container (cocktails), the Cook Off Committee needs to be made aware of this during the Cook's meeting so that appropriate containers can be provided. This will be the last item judged and is not taken into consideration for overall champion.
9. April 4th Turn in Times:

Chicken:	12:45p.m. – 1:00p.m.
Pork Ribs	1:45p.m. – 2:00p.m.
Brisket	2:45p.m. – 3:00p.m.
Wild Card:	3:30p.m. – 3:45p.m.

10. The Chief Cook is responsible for the conduct of the team members and guests. Excessive use of alcohol or abusive or profane language will be grounds for disqualification.
11. No food or alcoholic beverages are to be sold to the general public. **NO UNDERAGE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL!!**
12. The Chief Cook is to see that the contest area is kept clean and policed after the contest. Any space left in disarray or with loose or bundled trash and garbage will disqualify the team from future participation.
13. It is requested that the noise level be lowered after 10:00 p.m. Friday April 3rd , in order to keep peace and harmony with our neighbors.
14. A fire extinguisher will be required in each team area. There will be an inspection of fire extinguishers, if a team does not have a fire extinguisher by 6:00 p.m. Friday, the team will be subject to disqualification.
15. The Cook-off Committee reserves the right to make additional rules and regulations as situations may warrant. Any violation of the above rules and regulations will be grounds for disqualification. Decisions of the Cook-off Committee are final.
16. The Chief Cooks meeting will be at 4:00 p.m., Friday, April 3rd, 2020. **ITEMS CONCERNING THE COOK-OFF WILL BE DISCUSSED AT THIS TIME.**
