- 2. Review and renegotiate every utility contract the state has with service providers and eliminate all expense-padding and excess markup.
- 3. Write stricter requirements for all new state contracts that prohibit automatic upcharges and blind approval without a forensic financial audit of all amounts, figures and payment schedules.
- 4. Impose mandatory hard deadlines for delivery of information, reports and evidence;
- 5. Impose maximum five-business-day response time on all government inquiries and correspondence;
- Replace incompatible inter-departmental communication and data storage systems;
- Committees, sub-committees and studies that deliver no tangible results or implement no corrective actions must sacrifice the funding from within their own existing current budgets - no supplemental funds;
- 8. Precisely monitor assignments, committees, sub-committees and task forces to ensure that no tax dollars are wasted on redundant or contradictory efforts.
