
Abortion and Pregnancy Care

I fully support state and federally funded pre-natal medical and support care for all women, with the intent to prevent the need for abortion when possible. Fewer abortions will be necessary when women have access to all treatment and care needed to ensure their health and that of the fetus.

I believe that pregnancy care, as a whole, should be covered by medical insurance.

I strongly oppose any unconditional abortion ban that does not consider the circumstances of the pregnancy, such as rape, incest, and survivability of the mother and fetus.

I believe the government's involvement in any abortion case, and abortion overall, should not extend beyond ensuring and mandating the cleanliness, sanitary conditions and equipment of all medical clinics and facilities, licensure of the abortion practitioner, and protection of clinics and facilities from damage, threat and attack.

No politician, at any level of government, who is not a licensed gynecologist or womens' health provider, has neither the the knowledge nor expertise to intelligently assess or govern the medical complexities of pregnancy, womens' medical care, nor fetal care.
