

Data Centers

I am 100% against data centers being built in Georgia, particularly in our rural communities.

But **IF** they are forced upon us, as a state senator, I'm going to fight to make it mandatory that **ALL** data centers use pinnacle efficiency in all systems - at **THEIR** expense:

- ONLY cutting-edge closed-loop cooling systems;
- The nearest to silent-running routine operation that's possible;
- Maximum possible environmental contamination/damage containment and prevention technologies;
- 100% financial liability for all accidents, operational failures, and structural deficiencies;
- No tax exemptions. Percentile credits only.
- All existing data centers must upgrade to these standards within a reasonable time period not to exceed two years - at the owning company's expense - in order to continue being licensed or operational.
- A surety bond to protect counties and communities from any financial liabilities if the data center is closed, ceases operations, or is otherwise decommissioned.
- A mandatory price agreement of 150 percent of current fair market value, with legislative provisions that the power company cannot in any way pass those costs on to customers.

AI companies are already making vast fortunes from running data centers. I will **NOT** support taxpayer subsidy of companies that make billions in profits.
