ARTICLE VIII – GENERAL, JUDGED AND JURIED SHOW RULES

1. In order to show, a member must have attended three regular meetings during the year, and current dues must have been paid.
2. Entry fees are determined by the Show Committee.
3. Entries must be:
 - a. Properly framed and ready to hang, secure in the frame, matted where applicable, with a wire strong enough to support the weight of the entry. For canvas paintings, attach wire to frame. Wire must be taped; no sawtooth hangers.
 - b. Completely dry.
 - c. Within size limitations for the exhibit.
 - d. On quality materials.
 - e. Photographs and graphic arts must have a minimum size of 8"x10" and must be properly matted and framed.
 - f. If artwork requires special display, the artist is responsible for providing the same.

NOTE: Entries which do not conform to these conditions will not be accepted.

4. Work must be original, not copied from art books or other printed sources. Class paintings (unless original, one-of-a-kind. **ARTWORK MUST BE ENTIRELY THE WORK OF THE ARTIST.** Paintings from the artist's own photos are encouraged.
5. On the back of the artwork, tape show entry form.
6. In the event of disputes, a decision will be made by the Board and the Show Committee.
7. All accepted work **MUST** remain for the duration of the show.
8. Artwork that has earned an award for the artistic year (August through May), may not be shown again in any official PAG show, except as specified by the Board and explained to the members at a General Meeting.
9. Accepted entries may not be changed, substituted, or removed after close of registration.
10. At the conclusion of the exhibit, each artist must pick up work at the designated time. Failure to do so will result in handling and storage fees, not to exceed \$5 per day.
11. All artists must have a signed **Hold Harmless Agreement** with their entry form.
12. Gallery wrapped canvas (no frame), must be 1½ inches deep with no exposed staples.
13. In the event of a sale, a percentage of the selling price will be retained as commission to the venue and/or to PAG. This varies, so please check the form for details.
14. Exhibiting artists will be expected to sit the show and help with the reception as needed.
