Christina: There is a little discrepancy about the Policy, the policy that was voted in is the old Forest Area Policy, so if anybody is trying to go on to the Forest Area Policy, a lot of stuff in their new revised Policy has changed. Our policy is not the revised Forest Area Policy, our Policy is the one voted in prior to the revision. Some comments were made regarding the Policy for the Nature Cast Area not being finished yet, this Policy is tedious and painstaking. We have had to change it over from PDF to Word format and things have been gone through word by word. There are quite a few people working on it but we all have lives just like you and we are committed to getting it out as soon as possible and we apologize for the tardiness.

Rolland: Renee when does Policy Meet?

Renee: After area service, however, that may be changed because nobody met last month because everyone left after area. All are welcome.

Kelly: It was brought to my attention that at last area service my name was brought up and thrown around, if that is not true then that is ok. Umm... what I would like to ask, Ms. Treasurer, is everything now copacetic?

Dottie: I am the Alternate and I do not know

Kelly: Ok, Mr. Facilitator, is everything now copacetic?

Rolland: As far as I know that last Area Barbara presented, and it should be in the minutes,

Dottie: I do have her report

Rolland: So now I am not sure exactly what you mean by settled, it is kind of hard to settle everything when yu do not have everything.

Kelly: What I would like to say is that for 20 months almost 2 yrs I had nothing to do with the finances so if there is an issue it needs to be addressed within that 20 months and my name needs to stay out of this, I am done with my part in this financial part of this area. I would appreciate it if my name and this financial mess that we have is not mentioned because I have nothing to do with it. This scapegoat shit that we have going on trying to blame somebody really has to stop. As a member of Narcotics Anonymous I am feeling really hurt and disappointed. I served this area for 4 yrs and did the very best I could, I am over it, if there is a problem the 20 months that I did not serv needs to be investigated that is where it needs to start because my part is done and over with and I had nothing to do with this. If my

name continues to be drug through the mud, I am going to take this to region and have region address it. That's all I have.

Christina: I am coming out of love and respect; I believe that the thing that your name was brought up in last month was that we didn't have any reports from when you were acting treasurer.

Kelly: Yes you do it was turned in to area.

Christina: To who? I was Secretary and I do not have them.

Kelly: I gave every single GSR a copy.

Christina: It is not in the minutes

Kelly: Then somebody didn't do their job. It was there

Christina: Do you happen to have a copy of it?

Kelly: Yes I do, not with me but I do.

Christina: I am not accusing you of anything I just need a copy to attach to the minutes when you get a chance. To perfect the record.

Kelly: Rich you know that I turned it in

Rich: The first month that she was acting treasurer she turned in a report and the second month that she was acting Treasurer she did not turn in a report because things were up in the air and she didn't even know if she was sitting at the table that month.

Christina: What month because I should have it, I have the originals.

Kelly: It was April

Rolland: I think that the issue is that we had a relapse with our Secretary, am I correct in that?

Rich: No we are talking about this year.

Rolland: oh ok

Kelly: The first month I did a report and the second month I did not do because I was kicked out, Angel did that month.

Rolland: You were kicked out?

Kelly: Yes I was

Rich: I am here at every area and last month I did not hear your name bad mouthed. Hope Not Dope actually put in motions to keep bringing this thing back up, we had actually tried to move on from this and put things in order to make sure nothing like this ever happens again and Hope Not Dope asked Donnie to put in Motions again regarding all the financial stuff and bring all this stuff back around.

Kelly because...we were given a report from the Area that there were things that were not correct and all we asked fro was accountability for the 20 months, we have the right as members of NA to do that.

Rich: When was there was there 20 months of no reports turned in?

Kelly: 2018 and 2019

Rich: There was reports, I just did and audit.

Christina: I have April 2019 minutes right here, when you said that you turned in the report and it says, Treasurer's report not prepared or read. Kelly said that she has to take home all of the paperwork and go through it and she doesn't even have an accurate balance of the Area's Operating Account. Tommy said that he went to the bank and got statement from 2018 to now. Donnie asked if Angel turned in paperwork regarding accounting. Christina said no. Renee said that we cannot go into prudent reserve and that an audit cannot be completed without paperwork. The LDO card was rejected and Renee asked for accounting of the account. Tommy said that is why he has the statement and will go over them with the treasurer after the meeting. Robert motioned to table the treasurer's report until next month when a proper accounting can be given. Lois seconded. Tommy called for a vote and it passed 4 to 1.

Kelly: Is that April or May? The month that I was Treasurer a report was turned in.

Rolland: Ok point of clarity here, when you say Standard Operating Procedure were put in place so that this does not happen again that does that mean exactly?

Rich: That means with the Treasury, what we are putting in place now is receipts for anything in area no matter how small, our Treasurer is getting here early to conduct financial transactions so that we can have an accurate balance at the end of Area Service.

Kelly: I get that and I am ok with that but whatever happens from here forward and up into this point my name does not need to be addressed in here. I did what I was supposed to.

Rich: Your name came up in a very passive manner, nobody was saying that you did anything negligent or wrong I do not know where you heard that from but you can look in the minutes you were misinformed.

Rolland: Point of order let it be known, in the minutes, that Kelly's name will no longer be brought up on the floor at area service. Can we do that?

Judy: When our GSR comes back to us and tells us that for the last two months that there is no money in Area, we were told that there is no prudent reserve left and no money in literature and the campout money is not there. When I hear that my main concern is why is Area continuing to take money from the groups?

Rolland: Who in he room is a homegroup member of Hope Not Dope? It's nice to see y all, you are more than welcome to come to every area meeting so that you are not running on second hand information. I understand that you have a trusted servant who comes to bring group conscience but hopefully by the end of the day you will see.

Judy: So we do have our prudent reserve and we do have the campout money and literature money?

Rolland: Prudent reserve has never been touched; the \$800.00 for the Campout has never been touched.

Judy: We were told that when we were behind on the literature order, once that money was taken out there was no money left.

Christina: There has been a treasury report in each of the minutes that has come out that shows a breakdown of the money we have and it shows that it is not true. He is supposed to showing you guys the treasury report and accepting in or bringing back questions that you may have.

Judy: One other situation, I have served in Narcotics Anonymous since I have been here. Our GSR keeps coming back to the Home Group and saying, your name, Kelly's name and Tommy's name keeps being brought up I am like, why, everything is covered I turned in my report my money and everything was covered. There is not a \$100 dollars missing from activities? Why would I scam \$100.00?

Rolland: So let me get this straight, I gather your grup is here to attempt to move on from this?

Judy: Yes

Rolland: Can everyone be in agreement to move on from this?

Judy: But we want accountability for this time of question.

Rolland: We cannot do that accurately with all the things that are missing. That is why now things are in place so things are missing. Tommy would you like to speak to the money and the T-Shirts and the receipts?

Tommy: Yes, first of all I was raised in NA to be loving and caring, the T-Shirt situation, we got 20 t-shits and it cost us \$400.00, I took the \$400.00 out of my pocket got the T-Shirts and I had people who pre-ordered them. I picked up \$300 from that order and gave it to Judy and Judy then in turn gave me my \$400 back. I want to move on and for me to do that I have to come here and say my peace. I feel like what happened here at Area was an ambush and attack, I do not want to ever see that happen in Narcotics Anonymous again. I was hurt and going through so much in my personal life and not one person came to me and said hey what is going on, are you ok? I had somebody here run around like a crazy person tell me that we are going to do this or you are out of here, and that is not what we do in Narcotics Anonymous. I want to see that loving and caring come back; this area is so split up right now. When we had that Ad-Hock Committee and I was on it, we do not go behind one person on the committee's back and say we are going to change the date and time of the meeting so that Tommy cannot be here, that was wrong, that was totally wrong. If I did anything to anyone in these rooms to hurt you or did things you thought that I shouldn't have done, I apologize. I am back, all my situations at home are getting better because I do not pick up, as long as I didn't pick up I will be ok. I am helping with the campout and we need T-Shirts from different area campouts so we can do the quilt for raffle at the campout. Thank you I am back!!!

Renee: Thank you and if I did anything to harm you I too apologize. In the spirit of healing I would like to come forth with that. Umm... and this area has been looking t move on for a while, that is why we integrated the policy and everyone is accountable now such as receipts and spreadsheets so there is no room for guessing no wiggle room. I have no control over what comes out of somebody else's mouth, so when names get mentioned, from what I remember it was referring to whomever held that position at that time. I do not remember anyone being nasty or anything as that is not what we have been about, so I hope you will all come for the and we can get together and reunite the area because you have a lot of experience strength and hope and we need each other. That's all I got thank you.

Rose: I am new to the ASC here, we were trying to find the area policy, there is no way to find the current policy so that we can see what the requirements are.

Christina: We did not know that they had changed it over to their new policy so it had been available for anyone to look on their website and get the policy that we adopted into our

area. Our plan is to get out a rough copy of what we have on our website so that everyone can be privy to it. However, it is just brought to our attention.

Renee: Something was put out yesterday via texts that stated "I do not think asking her" (meaning me) "has any credibility". It is crap like that the smear crap, if you question my credibility, get to know me. I am not here to defend myself nor do I have to but its that kind of garbage that comes out of our mouths that Kelly is talking about that brings harm to each one of us. So I just wanted to bring that up.

Jason: What she is talking about has nothing of do with what you said that was something else, but the Policy has been handed out here all of us got a copy of it and they usually have it here sitting right in front of them so if they want to address something they literally have a policy in front of them at this meeting. They do try to make it available.

Dominique: My question was whether we were using the 2012 or the 2015 area policy and as far as credibility that was not meant as far as Narcotics Anonymous it was meant that if we do have a current policy to look at I do not know what has been amended in the policy since it was adopted. So I cannot look at this and wonder if there has been an update. If I am just coming to area I would not know what is on the policy. It had nothing to do with your credentials.

Rolland: No changes have been made and can't be made without voting.

Christina: I am explaining this to you over and over and over, no amendments have been made to policy that we have adopted. We have not changed one single word other than Forest Area to Nature Coast.
