We produced about 42 translated pieces of recovery literature, completed a draft of a new book to be decided upon at the World Service Conference, held quarterly open webinars on topics of Fellowship interest and bimonthly web meetings for Conference participants, produced draft service material for virtual meetings (www.na.org/toolbox), responded to requests for free or subsidized literature from incarcerated addicts and emerging communities, answered thousands of Fellowship emails and calls, and much more.




