Open Floor Comments: (30 Minute Limit)

Donnie: There is a rumor that our Activities Chairperson has plans on stepping down from the position, if this is true we (Hope Not Dope) have someone who would like t step up. My group would also like me to put in a motion stating that if no accounting is done and presented at area today, that all money in or out stops until we have a full and accurate accounting of the funds.

Rolland: When you say all funds, what do you mean by that?

Donnie: They want all funds to cease until we get an accurate accounting, they would like an outside audit to happen. There seems to be a good chunk of change missing?

Christina: You said that there was a motion put on the floor that there would be an outside audit that passed, that motion became moot when the original conditions that were placed in the minutes were not fulfilled. Next we pulled the minutes out this morning, all the originals and in two seconds we had already found a discrepancy in between the receipts and the reports of the people that are asking for the accounting. Unfortunately it is not a question of what area did with the money it is a question of what everyone including the people asking for receipts and accounting did with the money. It looks like we are going to have to go through the whole thing but first we need reports from all outgoing treasurers. Lastly at the Emergency meeting we discussed the outstanding invoices to the RSO and made a decision to go ahead and pay the invoices off. It wasn't that money was stolen or socked away ti was just that there was a lot of in and out with treasurers and miscommunications, but that was already accounted for and checked and taken care of.

Donnie: Area took it upon themselves to give the Ad-Hock committee an extra two weeks to complete the audit did they not?

Rolland: Yes we did

Donnie: Was that not against what the home groups voted for?

Jason: It was voted on here at area.

Rolland: We are going to limit the response to this to two minutes or less to keep it moving.

Rich: Really it was just group conscience to keep things moving along. We did however get new minutes and receipts to add to the audit, so that is why we were given the extra time.

Renee: according to the audit there were two months when treasurers did not turn that paperwork in right around the time of the campout. The only way to know stuff is to go back

through it and that takes time. However, to threaten area with the income coming in and out is not the right way to address any matter that you might have, we are not going to float or sink over one groups income, but I do want to complement the group for being conscience enough to address this if they do not see that it is appropriate, but to threaten the area is not appropriate, you should probably find another way of going about that.

Mary: I do not know if you were here but we did vote on letting them finish the audit for the extra two weeks on the floor. They were unable to produce a person willing ot d the audit for the specified amount of money and time so we decided on the floor to finish the audit here.

Jason: Hopefully to day there will be a balance and all this will not matter but, any group can make a motion all they want and it will be voted on by the home groups, if the other groups think it is good for the area then it will pass if not it won't. That is why the structure is set up that way.

Renee: The vote that went out on the audit it went out prematurely. We did not have all the information for an outside entity to do the audit accurately and they would have come up with the same thing.

Barbara: I do not like rebuttal and kickback but here we go, the whole thing was manipulation and it will reflect that in my report. The area decided to go on because certain things were not done certain ways. I haven't got a report on what kind of money came in and out those months. A couple of people in here have said that they will go to that person and get the reports but they haven't surface. Second you do not have an event and turn the money in two months later and say...this is how much we made, and then to hold the area hostage? I do not think do I think that they need to come to area and face us.

Dominique: Are we moving past this?

Rolland: yes we have 11 minutes left.

Dominique: Ok I have a question for policy. If you are the chair for a certain committee, how many meetings can you miss before you are removed from office 2 or 3?

Christina: 3

Rolland: Yes 3 so if they miss two but make it to the 3 then they made it.

Dominique: Ok thank you

Robert: Read aloud a letter that he wrote to the area regarding an incident last month. The grievance is attached in the minutes online at the Nature Coast Area Website.

Rolland: We will probably talk with policy to see if there is anything in policy to address this situation. It was very uncomfortable for me to reprimand my own sponsor. I had a conversation with him and told him that I didn't appreciate the situation that I was put in. I am learning here.

Renee: When two people are involved there are two people at fault. I have been in areas where they have physical fights but we are getting better. Two people were involved that is what I saw and if one of them get admonished the other one needs to be too. It has been attack and defends over the last two areas between these two individuals. There is nothing in the policy regarding this situation but it sure is in the steps. We can not ask a person to come to area, that I know for sure.

Robert: I am going to address the chair as it is improper for me to address anone else directly. What did I do that was wrong, because I just heard I was wrong?

Rolland: It takes two to tango and I can engage as much as I want. Just let it go.

Robert: That is what I did wrong. Thank you

Jennie: Rolland, I think you are doing a fabulous job.

Rolland: Thank you, we have 2 minutes, shall we move on? Ok


