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Distribution Information:

The Kiowa Tribe Higher Education Department has determined that Kiowa enrolled students attending an accredited adult vocational training program, university/college, or a certification/licensing program can apply for a **one-time** assistance for school-related items for the 2020-2021 school year.

What is needed for assistance?

- **School Assistance Application**
- **Verification of Kiowa enrollment:** Kiowa enrollment card or Kiowa enrollment verification letter. A CDIB will not be acceptable. The student *must be an enrolled Kiowa tribal citizen with a Kiowa Roll Number.*
- **Verification of School/Course Enrollment:** Kiowa students must be enrolled in an accredited adult vocational training program, university/college, or a certification/licensing program. This document can be obtained from the Registrar's office with a seal for term funded, an official class schedule signed by an academic advisor, an official transcript with pre-enrolled/in-progress classes listed for the term funded, etc. For certification and licensing we will need documentation from the organization/agency conducting training.
- **Letter of Intent:** A statement by the student, typed or handwritten, stating **why** you need extra funding and **what** it will be used for. The statement must be signed and dated.
- **Verifying documentation related to assistance needed.** *For example: If requesting a laptop, verification from the school stating the computer is necessary for online courses must be provided.*

What can be purchased?

Assistance is intended to be for the sole purpose of purchasing school-related items such as clothing, food, gas card, backpacks, laptops, tuition, school supplies, etc. Please contact our office for clarification on funding.

Receipts are required to be turned in to the Higher Education Department office within 30 days from receipt of the check. Students must ensure receipts are returned by the designated timeframe allowed. If your receipts have not been turned in, the student will not be eligible for future assistance.

Who may apply?

Kiowa enrolled tribal citizens who are attending an accredited adult vocational training program, university/college, or a certification/licensing program. Open to Kiowa citizens living in all seven districts.
