SUBJECT: SET POLICY FOR EXECUTIVE BRANCH TO DEVELOP, DOCUMENT AND APPROVE A KIOWA TRIBE STRATEGIC PLAN FOR SHORT RANGE (3 YEARS) AND LONG RANGE (5 YEAR) WHICH IS TO BE REVIEWED ANNUALLY AND MODIFIED AS NECESSARY TO ALLOW THE KIC TO BE AWARE OF FUTURE PLANS.

WHEREAS: the Kiowa Tribe is a sovereign nation since time immemorial and is federally recognized as a Tribal Government by the United States; and,

WHEREAS: The Kiowa Tribe is organized under a Constitution approved by tribal membership on April 17, 2017, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs on May 5, 2017; and,

WHEREAS: Article V, section 3(b) of the Constitution grants the Kiowa Indian Council the power to set policy for the Tribe, and shall have all other powers and duties specifically provided by the Constitution

WHEREAS: Set policy for Executive Branch to develop, document, and approve a Kiowa Tribe Strategic Plan for short range (3 year) and long range (5 year) which is to be reviewed annually and modified as necessary to allow the KIC to be aware of future plans.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Kiowa Indian Council hereby; Set policy for Executive Branch to develop, document, and approve a Kiowa Tribe Strategic Plan for short range (3 year) and long range (5 year) which is to be reviewed annually and modified as necessary to allow the KIC to be aware of future plans.
