**SUBJECT:           REQUEST FOR ENVIRONMENTAL TRASH BINS FOR ANADARKO AND/OR DISTRICT FOR HOUSEHOLD AND TRASH DUMPING**

**WHEREAS:**       the Kiowa Tribe is a sovereign nation since time immemorial and is federally recognized as a Tribal Government by the United States; and,

**WHEREAS:**       the Kiowa Tribe is organized under a Constitution approved by tribal membership on April 17, 2017, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs on May 5, 2017; and,

**WHEREAS:**       Article V, section 3(b) of the Constitution grants the Kiowa Indian Council the power to set policy for the Tribe, and shall have all other powers and duties specifically provided by the Constitution

**WHEREAS:**       **Dumping bin sites are needed for all Kiowa Tribe household members that live in “Kiowa” Country. Kiowa members dump their household trash in their backyards. This is a fire hazard and health hazard to the households. Kiowa Elders are especially at risk for the conditions of cluttered yards specifically at Apache Wye/Redstone areas, Anadarko, Oklahoma.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Kiowa Indian Council hereby; request for environment clean up by furnishing dumpster bins for removal of trash and household debris once a year.**
