Subsidy Eligibility Requirements

- Children ages birth 13th birthday
- Must be enrolled Kiowa, eligible to be enrolled Kiowa, or have at least one enrolled Kiowa parent.
- Must reside in Service Area
- Must meet income guidelines (less than 85% of state median income)
- All adults in household must be working or attending school or job training program
- Must NOT be currently receiving child care services from DHS or other tribal subsidy programs
