Called to Pray and Live Godly Lives

[2 Chronicles 7:14](#) "If my people, who are called by My name, will **humble themselves & pray & seek My face & turn from their wicked ways**, then I will hear from heaven, & I will forgive their sin & will heal their land."

[1 Timothy 2:1-2](#) I urge, then, first of all, that **petitions, prayers, intercession & thanksgiving be made for all people— for kings & all those in authority**, that we may live peaceful & quiet lives in all godliness & holiness. This is good, & pleases God our Savior, ⁴ who wants **all people to be saved & to come to a knowledge of the truth**.

We are called to have "the mind of Christ" ([Phil. 2:5](#)) in dealing with difficult people -- never contentious & un-Christ-like. [2 Tim 2:23-26](#) *"But refuse foolish & ignorant speculations, knowing that they produce quarrels. The Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, skillful in teaching, patient when wronged, with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, & they may come to their senses & escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will."*

What are the radical instructions given us by our Lord? *"Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who spitefully use you"* ([Luke 6:27](#)).

1. **"Love your enemies"** - *"Try to live at peace with everyone"* ([Rom 12:18](#)).

As much as I'd like everyone to like me, Jesus said, "Woe to you when all people speak well of you" ([Lk 6:26](#)). But this does not justify being obnoxious, argumentative or mean-spirited. We must "overcome evil with good" ([Rom 12:21](#)) & express genuine love toward all. When I'm tempted to rise up in anger & say nasty things, the Holy Spirit usually catches me & prompts me to pray for them, which I do despite my resistant "flesh." This releases God to move in them & me. No matter how hardened some may seem now, none of them are beyond the pale of God's love. Many raised in the Christian faith are prodigals; may Christians' prayers & kind behavior help bring them "home."

2. **"Do good to those who hate you."** Confused & resentful individuals who hate us for our identification with Christ or anything else, need to be on the receiving end of our understanding, mercy & the forgiveness of God.

3. **"Pray for those who spitefully use you."** In our attempts to extend God's love to confused or bitter detractors, our efforts may be rebuffed & we may be hurt or offended. May this not hinder our resolve to do the right thing in the right spirit ([Jas 2:13](#)). [Job 42:10](#): *"And the Lord restored the fortunes of Job when he prayed for his friends, & also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before."* Christians are being called to be His "ministers of reconciliation" to bring healing to our land.

For the sake of our children, generations, & state, we press on in repentance, prayer, AND action every bit as much as we did before, during, & after 9/11, elections, etc. Prayer made & will make a difference. Law-abiding citizens, especially young people, caught in the web of our culture's liberal ideological indoctrination, need to see Christian love & humility in action, even as we rejoice & continue to labor for revival & cultural change.

Remember ... no one else but Jesus Christ is the ultimate hope assured.
