It's a packed day of painting, learning, and sharing the hobby we love.





# HOBBY DEMOS & WORKSHOPS

At Clash on the Clyde, you'll find a weekend packed with tabletop hobby action. Whether you're a seasoned painter, a dedicated wargamer, or just starting out, there's something to inspire and entertain you.

Enjoy live painting showcases, from the fast-paced Speed Painting Demo to the creative Diorama Demonstration with Ross from <u>RS Wargaming</u>. If you're feeling competitive, take on the Speed Painting Challenge or enter your best work in the Best Painted Miniature Contest, with trophies and sponsor-supported prizes to be won.

Across the event, you can explore a variety of game demo sessions, including <u>BattleTech</u>, <u>Bolt Action</u>, <u>Necromunda</u>, and The War of the Rohirrim – Battle of Edoras, plus a special demo from Mantic Games Pathfinder Mark.

Alongside the action, you'll also find time to relax, recharge, and connect with fellow hobbyists. Enjoy a hot buffet of pizzas from Canotto's and a hearty breakfast courtesy of The Grubsmith, keeping you fuelled for a full day of painting, gaming, and fun.

## PAINTING COMPETITIONS

On Sunday, Clash on the Clyde will host two exciting painting competitions, giving hobbyists the chance to showcase their talent, test their skills, and win trophies and sponsor-supported prizes.

#### **Speed Painting Challenge**

Armed with the paints and materials provided, participants will have just 45 minutes to bring a miniature to life. To make things even more challenging, you'll be limited to using only three colours — so it's all about creativity, technique, and thinking outside the box. This fast-paced event is designed to be fun, high-energy, and unpredictable, with every brushstroke counting toward your final result.

#### **Best Painted Miniature**

Bring along your finest painted model and put it before a panel of live judges. Open to all skill levels, this competition celebrates the artistry, creativity, and dedication of our hobby community. Each entry will remain on display throughout the day, giving attendees the chance to admire the work up close. Judges will award prizes based on painting quality, presentation, and creativity, with a Community Choice Award allowing the audience to vote for their favourite piece.

Whether you're racing against the clock in the Speed Painting Challenge or showcasing your masterpiece in the Best Painted Miniature competition, both events are a fantastic opportunity to shine, share your work, and be part of the celebration.













## ENTRY RULES - BEST PAINTED MINIATURE

Show off your skills in the Best Painted Miniature Competition, open to hobbyists of all levels. This is your chance to display your work, gain recognition from the community, and compete for trophies and sponsor-supported prizes.

#### **Entry Rules:**

- Each entrant may submit one model only.
- Models can be from any manufacturer or range.
- The miniature must be painted entirely by the entrant commissioned work will not be accepted.
- All entries must be checked in by 12:30 PM on Sunday at the registration desk.
- Once submitted, models will remain on display for the duration of the event and cannot be removed until after the awards ceremony.

#### Judging:

 Entries will be judged live by an experienced panel, with attention paid to painting skill, creativity, and overall presentation.

Whether you're a seasoned painter or entering your first competition, this is a great opportunity to put your work in the spotlight.
