Aging Services

Since 1987, ACTIVE AGING, INC. has operated as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit entity that provides many different services for older adults living in Crawford County. The agency operates 5 centers around the county, 4 of which are open Monday through Friday and the one is open on Fridays. In addition, Active Aging, Inc. oversees several programs that provide in-home and other community services. These services are funded in part, through the Pennsylvania Lottery, Medical Assistance Funding, Active Aging Foundation and private donations.

All persons over the age of sixty who reside in the county may participate in the programs funded by the Area Agency on Aging. Federal regulations require the Agency to give preference to those persons over the age of sixty who are in the greatest economic and social need.

In-Home Services

Personal Care

Assistance with bathing, skin care, grooming, dressing, ambulation, meal prep or supplemental home support

Personal Emergency Response System

Buttons that can be worn on an older adult's wrist or around their neck that can signal for help in an emergency. Units can operate on a landline, cellular line or by GPS.

Service Coordination / Care Management

Staff complete assessments and care planning for older adults who require services in their home, facility, or other supervised living arrangement. Services are based on the needs identified by the assessment. Care Managers and Service Coordinators then monitor and assist the older adult to ensure their needs are being met.

Home Delivered Meals

Nutritious meals are delivered to eligible older adults, on a weekly basis. The older adult must be physically unable to prepare his or her own meal or have no one available to prepare a meal for them to be eligible.

Caregiver Support

Provides caregiver education, support and reimbursements of the cost of goods and services required to provide care for an older adult living in the community. Also provides reimbursement for those grandparents caring for a grandchild age 18 and younger. Reimbursement rate is based on household income.
