SWIMMING POOL SAFETY

MSN POOL PLASTERING takes swimming pool safety very seriously, and we offer the following information on how you can help keep your family safe:



- 1. Teach your children to swim.
- 2. Maintain adult supervision at all times, even if your children know how to swim.
- 3. We recommend that you not install a diving board, but if you choose to do so, periodic inspection of the board is necessary.
- 4. Insure that you have proper fencing, gates and locks and inspect them regularly to insure that they are functioning properly and self closing.
- 5. Learn CPR and maintain a first aid kit nearby.
- 6. Never swim when there is a possibility of lightening.
- 7. Never swim alone.
- 8. Do not leave air-filled toys or floats in the pool when not in use they can tempt children to reach for them.
- 9. Do not allow electrical appliances near the pool.
- 10. Know the depth of the pool and the shape of the pool bottom before you dive. (Always Hands In Front)
- 11. Avoid drains and other suction outlets.
- 12. Keep grates and drain covers in good repair and properly secured in place.
- 13. Have your pool and pool equipment inspected by a professional on a regular basis.
- 14. Go over all pool rules with friends prior to swimming.. This is to cover you!
- 15. Keep a phone nearby in case of emergency 911.
