

Director of Music Ministry – Christ the King – Delafield, WI

At CTK we value the ability of music to enhance and deepen our worship experiences.

Position Summary:

The Director of Music Ministry at Christ the King Lutheran Church (CTK) will collaboratively assist CTK's pastor in ministries related to worship and music. She/he will be responsible for developing, planning, leading, and supporting activities that will actively engage all people in worship through music.

This is a part-time position (estimated 20hrs/week) that could be filled by one or more individuals sharing responsibilities. This position does not include pension or health care benefits.

Desired Education and Experiences:

1. A bachelor's degree in music or equivalent education and experience.
2. Three to five years of organist and director of music experience.

Specific Duties:

1. Serve as Director for all musical groups
 - a. Recruit, teach, develop, train, rehearse, schedule, and lead a variety of vocal and hand bell choirs.
 - b. Work with CTK's pastor when scheduling and/or choosing music for groups or individuals.
 - c. Teach new liturgy and hymns to the choir and the congregation.
2. Serve as Accompanist
 - a. Work with CTK's pastor and the director of music to provide music for all worship services including weddings and funerals.
 - b. Make use of the organ, piano, electronic keyboard, and other instruments as appropriate for variety and enhancement of worship services.
 - c. Maintenance of musical instruments owned by CTK.
3. Manage the music budget in collaboration with the Worship and Music Committee.
4. Plan services and arrange for musicians to augment the worship experience when CTK's musical groups are not scheduled to participate and when absent from church services.
5. Work with the AV/ Tech team to provide appropriate sound and visuals to accompany musical performances.
6. Attend Staff and Worship and Music Committee meetings when possible.
7. Ensure music and hymn selections are supported by copyright. Maintain licensure and report use of copyrighted material to copyright license companies such as CCLI and One License.
8. Encourage participation in synodical and ecumenical choir exchanges.

Position Expectations:

1. Living out a Christian life that includes worship, study, service, and prayer.
2. Understanding of the Lutheran witness to the gospel.
3. Having the ability and willingness to articulate his/her faith.
4. Being willing to grow and develop in his/her abilities.
