

PHASE 2 of CTK re-entry

Phase 2 of CTK re-entry plan begins on Sunday April 4th per council electronic vote after the recommendation of the re-entry team. Highlights of this plan:

- Easter Sunday will have pre-registration for 100 slots, allows for 50 walk-ins.
- After April 4th, pre-registration will not occur.
- Capacity is increased to 50% or 150.
- Attendees will wear masks.
- Pastors, musicians, and other leaders are not required to wear masks while actively speaking. They will continue to follow distance guidelines. Bell covers will not be used on instruments.
- Congregation is still asked to refrain from singing or responses, and encouraged to hum or whisper quietly under mask. Singing is encouraged at outdoor services.
- All entrances will be open.
- Ushers will continue to direct seating and exiting process.
- Service details: length will increase to the typical service. Pastor's discretion to add lay assistants as needed.
- Offering will be collected upon entry/exit. Communion combo cups picked up upon entry.
- Coffee hour and meetings will remain via zoom or other technology.
