### **Re-Entry Update to the Congregation**

Our Re-Entry team has determined that it is safe for groups to meet with minimal restrictions. Please see the following highlights that will make gathering at CTK feel more "normal".

- All Bibles, songbooks, hymnals, and information cards will be back in the pews.
- More lay people will be participating in the services. Please feel free to offer your time and talents.
- The choir loft is no longer restricted to a minimum of musicians and group rehearsals may resume.

- All pews will be used except in one section. Every other pew will be used in the most east section or those who prefer more space.
- Internal and Community groups will be invited to meet under the same conditions as expected during pre-pandemic times.
- Indoor food fellowship and kitchen use returns.
- The sanitizer will continue to be available for use as desired.
- No mask is required for those who are fully vaccinated for Covid-19. A mask is recommended for those who are not fully vaccinated.

### **Family Promise Update**



Family Promise has continued to serve families throughout the pandemic and has expanded services to single women. The program also now includes two apartments for families who need shelter.

The return to the church rotation model may begin as early as January 2022. We are currently surveying our volunteers to be sure we have enough people to help us remain as a host church. We will continue to need cooks (solo or teams) to prepare meals, people to serve the meal and dine with the families (5pm-8pm) and volunteers to stay overnight and set-up breakfast (8pm-7:30am). Our church becomes a one-week shelter for up to four families 4-5 weeks of the year.
