Thank you so much to Christ The King for their support of my Eagle project!

My project, done over the summer, was the creation, collection, and distribution of washable cloth masks to those in need as well as the general public. This project was able to help a lot of people get the tools they needed to keep themselves as well as their community safe during this pandemic.



We had an overwhelming amount of support and were able to make and collect 2062 cloth masks. This project was done simultaneously in Wisconsin as well as in California.

We ended up with 1,405 masks collected and distributed in Wisconsin. 362 went to Outreach for Hope. 491 went to the Benedict Center. The remaining 552 went to the general public, 419 at the distribution event held at CTK. We had a total of 31 volunteers. The volunteers and I put in a total of 558 hours to this project.

I am really happy that we were able to help so many people. Thank you for your help in reaching our goal.
