
Outdoor Christmas Eve Drive Through Worship Experience

Did you know?

Congress passed provisions to encourage charitable contributions for 2020, a difficult year filled great need. For taxpayers who claim a standard deduction, of a \$300 above-the-line deduction can be claimed for cash gifts to eligible charities. Itemizing taxpayers can deduct up to 100% of their adjusted gross income in cash

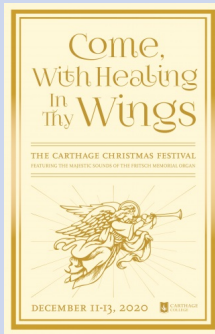
CTK Treasurer Position Open
