

Monday, December 21 from 4-8pm Ecumenical Longest Night Prayer Labyrinth "Blue Christmas"

Christ the King will join with its partners on the Longest Night Prayer Labyrinth.

the way in for instructions for walking the prayer labyrinth.

A prayer labyrinth is the spiritual practice of meditation and praying while walking a lighted winding path. In this Blue Christmas labyrinth, Laying down our burdens we emerge with greater strength and peace.

The Night of "The Christmas Star"

While the event itself takes place on 21 December, the planets will be close in the sky in the days leading up to it and afterwards. Look south-west as soon as the sun sets and find the brightest thing you can see. Because the timing coincides with the winter solstice, the shortest day of the year in the northern hemisphere, sunset will be early. Jupiter and Saturn will be low in the sky and will set quickly, so make sure you have a good view of the western horizon to catch them.

Matthew 2:1-11 "After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked, 'Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him.
