Project: Replace well tank and Iron filter




REFRESHING

Gutters

- Leaks in winter cause ice on sidewalks
- Many dents and in poor condition
- Downspouts send water near sidewalks

Project: Replace gutters



Air Conditioning Chiller

- Expected life 25 years.
- Currently 27 years old.
- 6 to 9 month lead time.

 Project: Replace chiller before it fails.





Exhaust Fan



- Current Exhaust Fans are inadequate.
- Doors are kept open with the excess air.
- Safety issue.

Project: Add additional exhaust fans.



Office Air Conditioning



- Three offices are on one zone.
- The offices all face different directions outside.
- It is not possible to set the heat or A/C, so that all three rooms are comfortable.


Project: Create three separate zones to allow for individual room settings.



REFRESHING

Lighting

- Current system is outdated, has reached end of life.
- Bulbs are getting difficult to purchase.
- Current lighting uses excessive energy.
- Poor lighting for the service.
- Poor lighting for video.
 Project: Upgrade lighting to LED to improve the lighting for church service and video.






Electrical Panel



- Panels are 57 years old
- Outdated technology
- · Reached end of life.
- Panel components are no longer available.

Project: Replace panel and relocate the panel and networking downstairs.



Utility Chase



- No longer need after electrical, A/C and lighting work.
- Opens up the entrance of the church.

Project: Remove the chase so that when entering the church the sanctuary is visible.





CHRIST THE KING CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

- 1. New Gutters \$40,000
- 2. Replace the Air Conditioning Chiller \$200,000
- 3. Install a New Exhaust Fan \$50,000
- 4. New Office Heating and Cooling \$60,000
- 5. New Electrical and Lighting System \$175,000
- 6. Remove Utility Chase \$50,000

Total Cost \$650,000

Includes \$75,000 contingency fund
