Nancy Yarbrough-Banks, survivor and founder of Fresh Start Learning in Milwaukee, says the women who stay overnight in the shelter called "Humble Beginnings" need flannel pajamas

(S-3XL) fuzzy socks and underwear.

Humble Beginnings, located in the 15th District, opened on Oct. 4, 2018 and has served more than 200 women, who are victims of sex trafficking and domestic violence. The beds are full Thursday night through Monday morning (the days the shelter is open). "We want the ladies to come in off the street, to take off the old and put on the new," Yarbrough-Banks explains.






