2. Release misconceptions about grief
3. Embrace the uniqueness of your grief
4. Explore what you might experience
5. Recognize you are not crazy
6. Understand the six levels of mourning
7. Nurture yourself
8. Reach out for help
9. Seek reconciliation, not resolution
10. Appreciate your transformation
