

Pastor's Ponderings

Challenges bring new opportunities to see God at work in our midst. I encourage you to pause and think about where you have seen God at work in your life and in our lives together as Christ the King who is "Alive and Growing in God's Grace." I've seen God at work this past month, accompanying me and us during this challenging time. The timing of discussing the book, "Canoeing the Mountains" is equipping the leaders of this congregation. The council has discussed core values in order to make decisions. We have discussed and acted on creating the conditions for a "Christ-like" environment through difficult decisions.

CTK is blessed with our personnel team: Toni, Meredy, and Andy. I appreciate their leadership, wisdom, and time over the past few months, leading us. I see God in the ELCA representative, Jennifer Arnold at the Synod, and pastoral care partners who have shepherded us during this time. CTK is also blessed with Barb Hamann who has spent countless hours figuring out the complicated payroll system and looking for cost reductions.

CTK now begins a new phase, moving into cottage meetings to assist with healing. From these, the data will be assessed and we will move forward with steps to shore up the resiliency of CTK. CTK is indeed canoeing the mountains, post-Christendom, post-COVID, etc. There are lessons to be learned from the past, work to do in the present, and hope for the future.

We are blessed that Sandy Reinhold joined our staff on August 4th as the Administrative Assistant and Becky Zelm joined as an interim musician. In regards to new staff vacancies, this is an opportunity for adaptive leadership---assessing what is needed in the future, what can be supported by the budget, and if there are ways to creatively meet the needs. Much like the MET team and call process, we will gather data, discern, and listen to God's Spirit before filling vacant positions. We will develop an interim plan for staff transitions.

In the days ahead, I encourage you to take time for self-care. Find a place or space where you connect with God. We move forward with faith, courage, following the lead of God's Spirit.

Family Promise has continued to serve families throughout the pandemic and has expanded services to single women. The program also now includes two apartments for families who need shelter.

The return to the church rotation model may begin as early as January 2022. We are currently surveying our volunteers to be

sure we have enough people to help us remain as a host church. We will continue to need cooks (solo or teams) to prepare meals, people to serve the meal and dine with the families (5pm-8pm), and volunteers to stay overnight and set up breakfast (8pm-7:30 am). Our church becomes a one-week shelter for up to four families 4-5 weeks of the year.
