Family Promise Update

Family Promise has continued to serve families throughout the pandemic and has expanded services to single women. The program also now includes two apartments for families who need shelter.

The return to the church rotation model may begin as early as January 2022. We are currently surveying our volunteers to be sure we have enough people to help us remain as a host church. We will continue to need cooks (solo or teams) to prepare meals, people to serve the meal and dine with the families (5pm-8pm), and volunteers to stay overnight and set up breakfast (8pm-7:30 am). Our church becomes a one-week shelter for up to four families 4-5 weeks of the year.

Reformation Lutheran Church

Marge Johnson, from Reformation Church, provided Outreach with an update which we would like to share with the congregation. Thank you for your continued support of Reformation Church!

- Thanks to Lynn Waedekin's idea and individual sponsorships, twenty of the older youth were able to attend the debut of Nelson Mandela: The Official Exhibition. Reformation used Nelson Mandela as a source of inspiration and a means of teaching non-violent problem-solving.
- Reformation hosted a Strong Women Strong Baby Fair in June with an attendance of 75
 people. Diapers, many donated by CTK, were given to the mothers with babies. All parents and
 caregivers were trained in Infant Safe Sleep. Lead-filtering water purifiers were also given to
 parents with toddlers.
- The SALT Youth Work Ministry began in July. Forty-six children and young people were enrolled in the program and ALL 46 successfully completed the program.
- Reformation wants to do what is best for its neighborhood and the people it serves and is currently
 exploring options for the Neighborhood Store. They are working with experts on church thrift store
 management through "Catchafire" a grant through the Siebert Foundation.

Reformation continues to host SONshine pantries. Thank you to CTK for donating items, TP, laundry detergent... to help stock the pantry.
