



Successful School Supplies Drive for MRM

Thanks to our generous congregation at Christ the King, we collected **\$996** for School supplies and Chrome Books for children at Milwaukee Rescue Mission's Cross Trainers Academy! Cross Trainers Academy is a private, Christian school serving at-risk children in Milwaukee. Almost all of those dollars were collected and submitted by the 8/31 matching date. With the matching funds, that is nearly \$2K that is going to aid the poor in Milwaukee!
