Update on Family Promise:

Family Promise of Western Waukesha County has not housed families since the outbreak of COVID19 in mid March. The Day Center is still in operation assisting alumni families and call from families. They are assisting families with supplies, gas cards, store cards, vehicle repairs, etc. You can imagine the need is great with decrease work hours and lay offs.

Our next host week was scheduled for Oct. 11-18th. At a volunteer coordinator meeting it was suggested that in lieu of the churches hosting during their week if they would be interested in having a collection for items that the Day Center needed at that time.

Our support churches, St. Joan of Arc and St. Katherines, and Christ the King will collect needed items for the Day Center. We will be collecting the items at the Oct. 11th outdoor service which would have, coincidentally, been the start of our Host week!

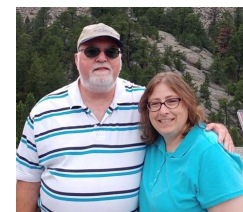
