

Let's turn up the heat by bringing in your Undesignated Contributions! Our YTD 11/30/25 net loss from ordinary operations is (\$8.7k). As of 11/30/25, we are \$108.8k below our 2025 budget of \$362k. However, in light of our below budgeted expenses this year and the amazing generosity of the congregation to the mortgage payoff and capital improvements campaign, we lowered our 4th quarter goal to \$90k.
