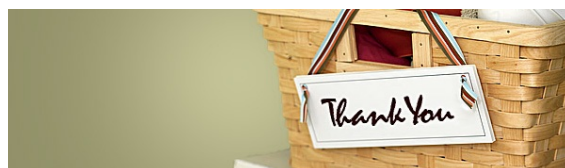

Exciting Family Promise Update

Family Promise is working hard to return to the church rotation model. Rotations used to mean the families would move their



belongings to a different church each week. They slept in their make-shift bedrooms in that church for one week. The following week, they moved their belongings to a different church. If a static site can be secured, the church volunteers will be rotating instead. Each week a different church would take the meals to the families at that static location. We would still provide food, fellowship until bedtime, supervision overnight, and the drag-and-go breakfast for one week. Yes, we would have to drive a bit, but the families will feel more settled staying

in one location and our church would not need to physically host multiple families. We just need our wonderful volunteers! If all things fall into place, this may happen in February...or March of 2022.

CTK members will hear directly from the executive director of Family Promise of Waukesha County on Sunday, October 10th when he comes to CTK to tell us more about preventing homelessness in our own backyard. **Joe Nettesheim** will share statistics regarding the number of people the organization has been able to help since 2014 and especially during Covid. **Click here** for more information.
