

Tom unfortunately passed away in October 2020. Recently, a plaque was installed on the sign to Honor Tom's memory (pictured left).




DT MENTORS

Christmas Project for The Women's Center in Waukesha

Since 1977, the mission of the Women's Center has been to provide safety, shelter and support to empower all impacted by domestic abuse, sexual violence, child abuse and trafficking. As the only agency of its kind in Waukesha, they envision an engaged community that does not tolerate or accept interpersonal violence and provides abundant resources to ensure futures free from violence.
