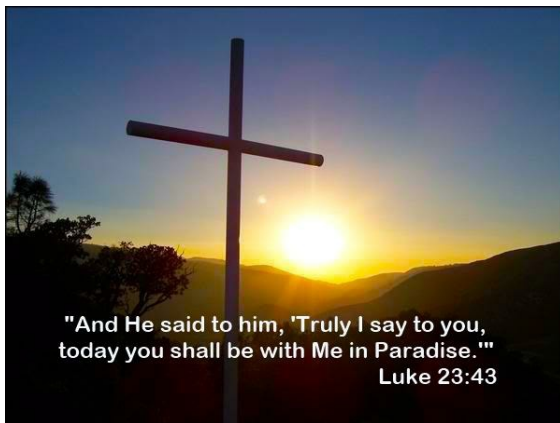

The 2020 Mission Trip for Adults is now forming. We are heading to the Panhandle of Florida, to help those affected by Hurricane Michael.

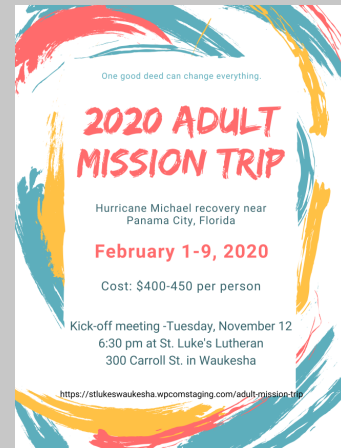
