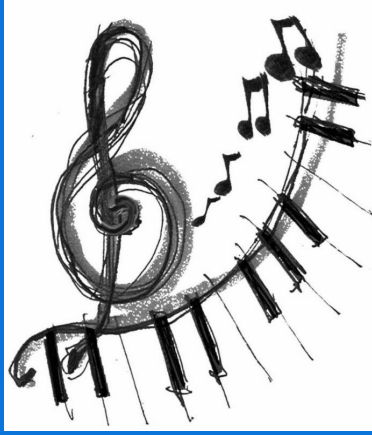

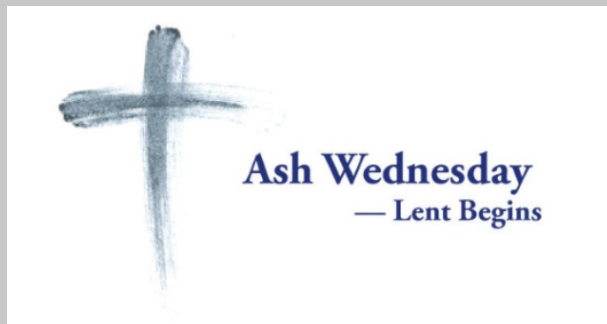

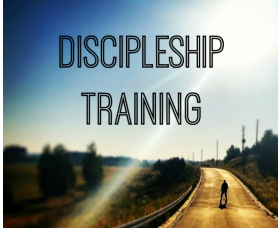

2020 will be a big year for the state of Wisconsin. Two major events drawing hundreds of thousands of guests from around the world will be happening within months of each other. In July, the Democratic National Convention will be hosted in Milwaukee and in September, the Ryder Cup will be coming to Kohler. With an estimated total of 50,000 guests projected for each of these events, that's a significant increase in potential revenue for our state, especially for the hospitality industry.

Those of us in the anti-human trafficking field understand that, when there is a large influx of people with disposable income, an increase in commercial sexual exploitation and other forms of human trafficking quickly follow. Worldwide studies show that both labor and sex trafficking drastically spike around large events, sporting and otherwise by approximately 179% according to Traffick911's research.

We will not stand for it. Join a growing list of organizations in Wisconsin in taking a collective and collaborative stand against human trafficking in 2020. 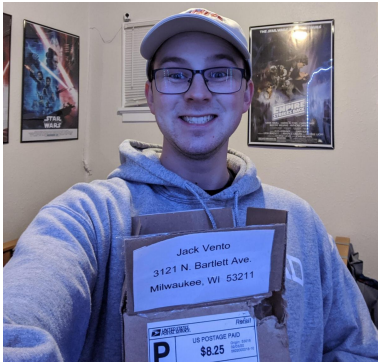
