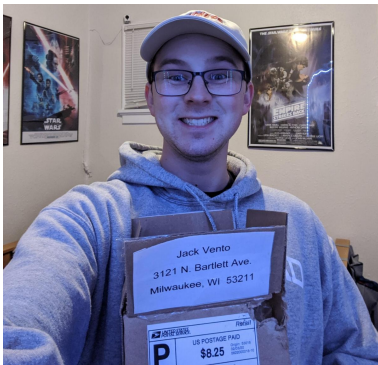

A sandwich board provided by Carol White will be outside announcing the service on the days it is offered. The ushers will be recruiting drivers who will park your car for you so that you can get out of your vehicle at the door. Others will be available to assist those wanting to walk. We will also have a wheelchair and can offer a personal ride in the wheelchair!

Assisting others in this way will require volunteers! Those with winter driving experience and a valid driver's license are asked to help as a valet. Those who are steady on their feet and have appropriate footwear for the job are invited to assist walkers or offer the wheelchair service. 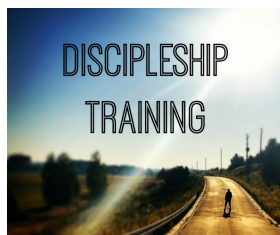
Question: I changed my pledge for 2020 on my pledge card, but it has not been reflected in my automatic withdrawal.

Emmy Myers - Local trafficking survivor, advocate, speaker, Shared Hope Ambassador, and Founder of Lacey's Hope Project, a survivor-founded initiative devoted to shedding light on sex trafficking that happens every day, everywhere. Through community awareness and education, we will dispel myths about sex trade and drug addiction, encouraging prevention and offering actionable solutions.

Eric Szatkowski - Retired Special Agent with the Wisconsin Department of Justice/ Division of Criminal Investigation with 16 years at the state's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force in Milwaukee. Dedicated to protecting children from predators, pornographers, sex traffickers, and bullies, Eric shares techniques used by predators and advice on internet safety. Eric was responsible for the arrest of approximately 200 suspects from Wisconsin and around the country, many of whom traveled various distances to have sex with what they believed to be an underage boy or girl.


