## **Unprepared But Still Ready**

The early snow and sudden cold snap caught me unprepared this year. Leaves still cover much of my yard underneath the snow. Even the city crews didn't get the chance to collect leaves at the side of the curb. I am still trying to play catch-up with my projects to get ready for winter. The season of Advent is upon us and again I feel unprepared. But wait a minute. Advent is a time for preparation and getting ready for the celebration of the birth of our Savior and his return in glory.

The practices of the season will help us get ready and be prepared. Advent literally means "coming". Take a breath and slow down a little.

Let the traditions of Advent help you to prepare your hearts for the great celebration of the birth of Jesus. Since the twelfth century, during the time of Bernard of Clairvaux (d. 1183), Christians have celebrated three "comings", the coming of Christ at Bethlehem, the Savior coming daily into our hearts, and finally Christ's return in glory. Simple devotional practices will help you get ready for the season.

A home Advent wreath is a practice that you may already use, accompanied by a prayer and scripture each time the candles are lit. It won't be much trouble to find an Advent calendar in the stores since they seem to grow in popularity each year. My family likes the chocolate ones. Find a movie that speaks to your heart about the focus of the Christmas season. For many years during the early part of December we read "The Best Christmas Pageant Ever" and watched the movie starring Loretta Swit. This story that features the Herdmans, a hard-luck ragtag bunch of kids that seem bent on destroying the local Methodist congregation that is preparing for a Christmas Pageant, might melt your heart just as it does mine each time I see it.

Whatever your plan, make it simple. The first Christmas was simple, but with some spectacular special effects and an eternal outcome. May Christ's coming, as a baby born in Bethlehem, his coming into your heart each day, and his return in glory, change us all as we reflect his joy to the world.


