#endhumantrafficking prayers available for four weeks leading up to the Super Bowl

Since at least 2005, Women of the ELCA participants have been actively working to end human trafficking. At the Eleventh Triennial Convention (2021), the voting members adopted a resolution setting the four weeks prior to the annual NFL Super Bowl as a time of prayer to end human trafficking and called on women of this organization to engage in prayer.

Nine women have written 28 prayers to use in the four weeks leading up to the Super Bowl. They can be prayed individually or in group settings. Use them at circle meetings or other any gathering of people of faith.
