We completed the shopping for The Women's Center. We were able to get all things from our list for the children and most things for the mom. . Toys, books, shoes, clothes, bath and body set, air fryer and a gift card to Walmart. Thanks to **all** of CTK for making this family's Christmas very merry!

For this family, we spent \$311.91 along with \$97.50 in-kind shopping that did come from the list.

Another member wanted to donate to help the needy today so we used that \$50, with the donor's permission, to purchase a gift card from Walmart for Christine and her family of 3 children. I did mail that to her today in a Christmas card signed from Christ the King Church and an invite for her to reach out to us as needed.

We have a February project for hygiene products for Kettle Moraine School District for the social worker, Baylee Kittel. Shelly was already checking for toothbrushes and she got 98 sets (brush, toothpaste, floss and timer for young ones to time their brushing). Those were delivered to Baylee- no reason to hold onto them - along with a donation of sanitary supplies that she has requested. Baylee already emailed me with a huge thanks for those donations!!
