CTK Pipe Organ News

We are about to perform a significant upgrade to the CTK organ. Our CTK organ was completed in 2000 following 5½ years of negotiations, fundraising, construction, and regular updates to the congregation. I participated or lead in all of those.

Since that time only tuning and emergent repairs were performed, primarily by Organ Associates of St Paul, MN, Timothy Patterson. In 22 years nothing has been spent on enhancements beyond the Zimbelstern, which was a special gift.

The organ is nearly fully functional, but there are areas of the organ that cannot be utilized due to the age and deterioration of some of the leather valves. These are not surprising issues as parts of this organ are nearly 100 years old. Those repairs are quoted at \$8,600, well beyond the Organ Tuning and Service budget. These repairs will remain on the Wish List as repairs are not a function of the Organ Fund. Today's proposal does not deal with those service issues. However, 12 fuse failures in the past 3 months will be solved by this proposal.

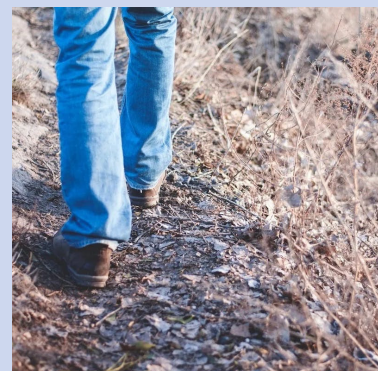
