This week, we're kicking off our countdown with an email celebrating the 15th year of our Family Ride Run Walk. Read on to learn about the history of the event, our organization, and the vital work your participation supports!

What's the history of this event? The Outreach for Hope Family Ride Run Walk (formerly Family Bike Ride) started in 2008, when a handful of Outreach for Hope supporters organized a bike ride fundraiser and picnic. In the 15 years since, the event has taken on a life of its own, with dedicated participants and volunteers coming back year after year to raise over \$1 million for grants to our Ministry Partners. It is now our organization's largest annual fundraiser.

Who does the event benefit? 100% of your support goes towards our \$165K fundraising goal will directly fund grants to central city congregations in our Synod. These Ministry Partners across Southeast Wisconsin not only provide help with daily necessities like food and clothing needs, medical wellness clinics, and youth and elderly programs - to name just a few; they are also centers of transformation, faith, and hope in the heart of their communities

New ----988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline ----free and confidential support for anyone

experiencing a suicidal, mental health, and/or substance use crisis. People of all ages who need help for themselves or a loved one can access the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline by:

- · Calling 988 (multiple languages).
- · Sending a text message to 988 (English only).
- · Using the chat feature at <u>988lifeline.org</u> (English only).
- The 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline is the new name for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, which has been available since 2005.

Wisconsinites who use the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline will connect with Wisconsin Lifeline, an in-state support center where trained counselors answer calls and texts. Wisconsin Lifeline counselors are trained to reduce stress, provide emotional support, and connect people with local resources. The helpline is available at no cost to Wisconsin residents. Additional care or intervention that may result from contact with the Wisconsin Lifeline may come with a cost. Wisconsin Lifeline is not able to send an in-person response directly. An in-person response requires a transfer to another service and could involve law enforcement.

Calls, texts, and chats with Wisconsin Lifeline are kept confidential between the person and counselor unless there is imminent danger for the person or others.
