How do I get a fundraising page?

An individual fundraising page will automatically be created for you when you register here (see help article here if you get stuck). Be sure to save the login information you set up during registration, and make sure you get a confirmation email!

Can volunteers and fellowship-only participants fundraise too? Absolutely! And the registration process is the same as for a rider, walker or runner.

Do I have to join a fundraising team, too?

No, you don't have to be part of a fundraising team to fundraise as an individual -- but you're welcome and encouraged to fundraise as both an individual and as part of a team (learn more about teams in <u>last week's countdown email</u>).


