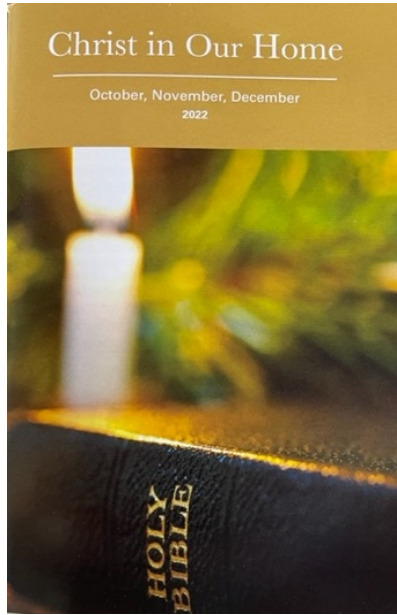
### What to Expect at Worship

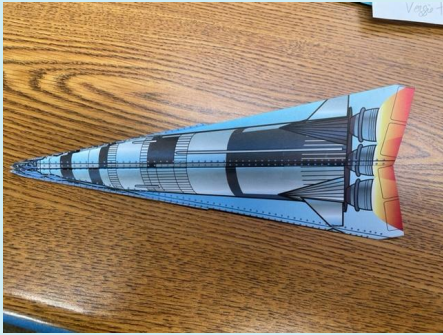

The CTK Rain Garden is in full bloom and working hard to cleanse the air of Co2 pollutants and remove the storm water runoff of contaminates. More than ever it is so important for the recently designated “endangered Monarch butterfly “ and all other pollinators.

The migratory monarch butterfly (*Danaus plexippus*) was recently added to the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species™ as Endangered. Habitat destruction and fragmentation, increased use of pesticides, and a changing climate have



been key contributors to the monarch population decline.

The good news? You can help; and it's easy! Just plant some native milkweed and companion nectar plants outside your home (and encourage others in your community to do the same). You'll be helping monarchs as well as other important wildlife species like bees and birds. And wildlife presence can double in just one season!
