Overview of lessons:

1/10/2	The 1 Disciples	12 Disciples Names- Color the 12 disciples and glue them to popsicle sticks to create puppet. Use the puppets to act out the stories this month.
1/17/2	The 1 Disciples	Fishers of Men! Cut out the fist and color them. Write names of people who are Jesus' disciples on them. Put them on the blue plate. Weave the string around the plate to make a net. You are a fisher of men!
1/24/2	The 1 Disciples	You are a follower of Jesus! Make hand or foot prints to remind yourself to follow Jesus every day!
1/31/2	The 1 Disciples	My family follows Jesus! Create picture frames and a photo of your family. Put on the door of your house to remember where ever you go you can follow Jesus!
2/7/21	The Fruit of the Spirit	Spirit Cups! Stack the cups up and say the fruit of the spirits as you go. How fast can you say the fruits?
2/14/2	The Fruit of 1 the Spirit	Rainbow Fruit! Create a rainbow fruit by tearing colorful paper and putting the pieces together.
2/21/2	The Fruit of 1 the Spirit	Fruit Basket! Create a fruit basket by cutting out the basket and fruits. Can you remember what each fruit represents?
2/28/2	The Fruit of 1 the Spirit	Playdough Fruits. Call out a fruit and make that shape. Then recall what the fruit of the spirit is!
