JOB REQUIREMENTS

Position: Patrol Officer

- Must be at least 21 years of age when appointed as a Police Officer.
- Must be a United States Citizen.
- Must be of good moral character.
- Must have not been arrested or convicted for any crime of Battery or Domestic Battery.
- Must have not been arrested or convicted of any Felony.
- Must be a resident of Indiana, and a surrounding county of Jackson County.
- Must have a valid Indiana Driver's License.
- Have minimal driving and accident record.
- Have a good work record with previous employers.
- Be in sound mental and physical health.
- Have a High School Diploma, or its equivalent as accepted by the Superintendent of Public Instruction for the State of Indiana.
- Have vision of at least 20/30 corrected in each eye.
- Maintain working telephone and inform the police department of current telephone number.
- Be willing to work a revolving schedule.
- Maintain training required by law.
- Meet all training requirements for a Police Officer as prescribed by Indiana Law.
- Submit to being fingerprinted.
- Submit to background investigation, driving record inquiry, and any other requirements set forth by the Crothersville Police Department or the Town of Crothersville.
- Must be willing to appear for interviews before the Command Staff and Town Council.
- Refrain from any political activity prohibited by law or that would create a conflict of interest as a member of the police department.
- Must be able to successfully complete the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy Physical Entry Standards.
- Must be able to successfully complete the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy Basic Course and complete the ILEA Physical Exit Standards.
